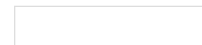

Williamson Completes Green Projects

The Town of Williamson has finished some projects that will help offset the town's carbon footprint.

Using federal stimulus funds, Williamson now has a new wastewater plant that will conserve both energy and water.

The project includes a solar array producing as much as 80,000 kWh each year. It is expected to save taxpayers thousands of dollars each year.

Also, a new belowground water tank will help the town reuse rainwater.

Town officials have scheduled an open house and public ribbon cutting on Monday from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. at the Williamson wastewater treatment plant.
